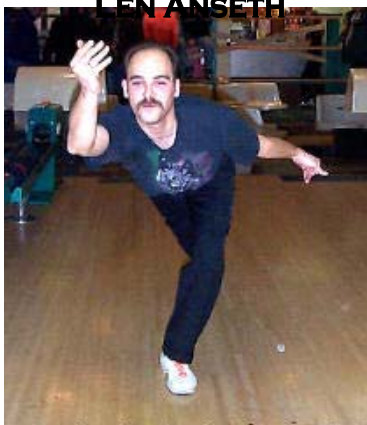

Len threw 4 strikes in a row from the 6th to 9th frames on his way to a 317. Due to 4 headpins Jim finished that game with a 195. It was the second time that Len beat Jim in the tournament as Len won the B final 873 to Jim's 758 to set up a rematch for the championship
