

2004 Brewhouse ~ Jubilee Ford Open

Kevin Holdsworth of Calgary claimed his second Jubilee Ford Brewhouse Open Championship by defeating Jim Llewellyn of Winnipeg at the K.G. Bowl today. Holdsworth served notice in the qualifying round that he was going to be a force in this year's event by qualifying first overall with a 300 average for 8 games. In the final, Holdsworth took command with games of 292 and 268 to lead by 155 pins going into the last game. Llewellyn made a spirited run by throwing 4 strikes in a row early in the third game. Holdsworth answered with 3 strikes in a row of his own giving Llewellyn very few frames to make up the 155 point deficit. When Llewellyn's string of strikes ended, he conceded the match to Holdsworth.

Holdsworth and Llewellyn both advanced to the final by beating Winnipeg's Rob Shanas who was almost the story of the tournament. Shanas bowled 30 games today in an unsuccessful bid for the 2004 Championship staying alive on both sides of the event until the final match where fatigue proved to be a factor in his losses to Holdsworth and Llewellyn.

The Consolation winner held at Eastview Bowl was Bob Medforth of Swift Current who downed Jared Wright of Saskatoon.
